WINEMAKING:

The fermentation process begins after a gentle harvest, in stainless steel tanks around 25 °C to preserve the characteristics of the berries. About 80% of the wine is transferred to French and American oak barrels for 8 and 10 months.

Perfect with pasta dishes, such as lasagna or fettuccini al pomodoro, and mature cheeses.
